PASSENGER NAME:

Passengers are responsible to ensure that the names printed on the invoice exactly match the first and last name written on their passport. Due to newly introduced security measures, any name change including minor spelling correction may require airline reservations to be cancelled and rebooked. Reservations are subject to availability at the time of booking. Once final payment is received, airline tickets will be issued. Subsequent name corrections will be subject to an airline rebooking fee of up to \$400 per ticket plus a Globe Travel \$75 revision fee per change. ITINERARY

Sunday: Miami – Tel Aviv

Arrive Miami Airport at 1pm for your flight to Tel Aviv via Zurich. Scheduled departure at 5:00pm.

Monday: Tel Aviv

Arrive Tel Aviv at 2:30pm transfer to your hotel. Day at leisure. (D)

Tuesday: Tel Aviv, Caesarea, Meggido

Depart Tel Aviv heading North. First stop is Caesarea, once the capital of the Roman province. See Roman and Crusader remains as well as the harbor from which St. Paul was taken to Rome as a prisoner. Proceed to Meggido, overlooking the Jezreel Valley, considered the Armageddon of the New Testament. Overnight in Tiberias. (B,D)

Wednesday: Galilee, Boat Ride, Capernaum, Tabgha, Mt. Beatitudes

Take a boat from Tiberias to Capernaum to see an ancient synagogue and St. Peter's house which was later converted into a church. Also by the shore, visit Tabgha with the Church of Peter's Primacy and the ancient mosaic of the Loaves and Fishes. Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes, the site of the Sermon on the Mount. Return to Tiberias for overnight. (B, D)

Thursday: Haifa, Mukhraka, Cana, Nazareth, Tabor

Drive to Mt. Carmel in Haifa, viewing the Druz villages and Mukhraka for spectacular views of the northern region. Visit Cana, scene of the first miracle, and the Church of the Wedding. Then to Nazareth to see the oldest Church of the Annunciation with Mary's Well. Return to hotel in Tiberias. (B, D)

Friday: Tabor – Jericho – Bethlehem

In the morning, visit Mt. Tabor, site of the Transfiguration. Leave through the Jordan Valley Rift to Jericho. In Jericho, see the excavations of the oldest city in the world. View the Mt. of Temptation. Continue to Bethlehem to see the Church of the Nativity and the cave-stable of Jesus' birth. Proceed to Jerusalem for overnight. (B, D)

Saturday: Mt. of Olives, Gethsemane, Mt. Zion

Drive to Mt. of Olives for a wonderful view of Jerusalem. See the Place of Ascension, the Pater Noster Church, and the Palm Sunday Road. At the foot of the hill, see the Garden of Gethsemane with its ancient olive trees and the Church of All Nations. Drive through the Kidron Valley and see the Pool of Siloan and St. Peter in Gallicantu, built over the palace of the High Priest Caiaphas. On Mt. Zion, visit the tomb of David, the Upper Room, and the Church of Dormition. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)

Sunday: Cathedral of St. George Attend the Arabic service and enjoy tea with them. Then attend the English service and have lunch at the Cathedral Guest House. Balance of day for relaxing. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Monday: Old City–St. Anne, Via Dolorosa, Christian Shrines, Tower of David, Western Wall

Enter the Old City through the Lion's Gate. See the Pool of Bethesda, where the angel ruffled the water, and St. Anne's Church, traditional birthplace of Jesus' mother. Continue on the Via Dolorosa (Stations of the Cross) to the Church of The Holy Sepulcher through the Jewish Cardo and stop at the Western Wall. Leave the city through the Dung Gate. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)

Tuesday: Ein Karem, Lunch with families, Shepherds' Field

Visit Ein Karem to see the Church of St. John the Baptist. Drive to Bethlehem and have lunch with a Palestinian Christian Family. Visit the Shepherds' fields. Overnight in Jerusalem (B, L, D)

Wednesday: Bethany, Mt. Massada, Qumran, Dead Sea

Drive to Bethany, home of Martha, Mary and Lazarus. See the wine press. Drive along the shore of the Dead Sea to Mt. Massada, the last stronghold of the Jewish resistance to the Romans. Continue to Qumran site of the Essene enclave and see the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. On the way back to Jerusalem, float in the Dead Sea. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, L, D)

Thursday: Israel Museum, Model, Emmaus

Visit the Israel Museum to view the Dead Sea Scrolls and the Model of the Second Temple as it was in the time of Jesus. Drive to the village of Emmaus, stop at Abu Gosh. Overnight in Jerusalem. (B, D)

Friday: Allenby, Baptismal Site, Madeba, Mt. Nebo, Petra

Leave Jerusalem and cross into Jordan at Allenby. Stop at the traditional site of the Baptism on the Jordan River. Visit the Christian village of Madeba to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land. Drive to Mt. Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land, with views of the Jordan Valley, Jericho and the Judean hills. Also see the remains of Byzantine

church with their mosaic floors. Continue to Petra for Overnight. (B, D)

Saturday: Petra

Full day to explore the Red Rose city of Petra. You have the choice to walk or take a horse ride through the dramatic sandstone canyon known as the "Siq. See the Treasury, carved in the pink stone, and continue to the Roman theatre, the Corinthian Tomb and Palace Tomb to the Roman road. Optional 60 minute walk to the Monastery offers one of the best views in Petra, Overnight in Petra. (B, D)

Sunday: Wadi Rum, Amman

Visit Wadi Rum, also known as "Valley of the Moon". The landscape of Wadi Rum – with its immense size, color and awe-inspiring shapes – creates an almost supernatural atmosphere. Explore the rose-tinted mountains and marvelous desert vistas where T. E. Lawrence (Lawrence of Arabia) lived with his Bedouin allies during World War I. Wadi is still home to a number of Bedouin families. Drive to Amman for overnight. (B, D)

Monday: Amman City Tour, Jerash

This morning enjoy a tour of Amman. Originally built by the Romans 2000 years ago, they called it Philadelphia. See the Citadel, containing some of the Roman ruins, and the Amphitheatre. Drive to the uniquely preserved Roman city of Jerash, popularly called the Pompeii of the East. See the Elliptical Forum, the street of columns, the Temple of Artemis, and Roman theatres. After lunch cross into Israel; Enjoy a special farewell. (B, D)

Tuesday: Tel Aviv – Miami

Early AM departure from Tel Aviv. Arrive Miami 5PM. (B,L).
